- Beach House Shore line planting design – Options were discussed and Bob to work on a design options. Stated that he would be able to donate his time and equipment.
- Cell Phone Tower update – MaryFran has contacted a representative that told her that the budget for this type of project renews in Jan 2025 and to check back at that time.
 - The township approval should not be an issue if the carriers are interested in locating a tower in our area.
